PRESENTATION

While the whole world observes the impacts of the international scenario on the global economy, Brazilian agribusiness is continuously developing and expressing its strength. The information on this Agri in Data Bulletin outlines this reality.

Goiás has achieved remarkable results this year. Taking the GVP numbers into consideration, for instance, the Brazilian Gross Value of Agricultural Production is estimated to be R\$ 647 billion, which represents an increase of 6.7% compared to 2019. Whereas, the estimate for the State GVP is 54.9 billion, an increase of 8.5% in relation to the previous year. Goiás grows more and more, as consequence, it brings positive impacts on the farmers' income and on what they return to society in opportunities and regional development.

This Agri in Data issue also stands out the 5th Grain Crop Survey -2019/2020, provided by the National Food Supply Company (Conab). The estimated production of more than 24,571.0 thousand tons of grains highlights products such as soybean (12,053.3 thousand tons), corn (10,863.4 thousand tons), beans (319.9 thousand tons) and sesame (2.1 thousand tons). These results will increase our exports and contribute to our trade balance. Besides, you will find some information about the institutions under our jurisdiction - Emater, Ceasa and Agrodefesa, with emphasis on the numbers of the Agro é Social program.

I also announce that, considering all these promising scenarios, the Government of Goiás opens, from this month onwards, special credit for farmers, especially for the small ones, by using the credit line Produtor Empreendedor - Crédito Rural. According to the Governor's guidelines, the rural credit will be offered to attend family farmers, rates from zero to 0.5%, working in partnership with the Secretariat of Industry and Commerce (SIC). It is a another way of making the numbers we present in this bulletin increase even more, stimulating the development of rural activities and of the whole state.







GVP OF LIVESTOCK -GOIÁS














