GLOSSARY

Soybean Complex: products resulted from soybean cultivation - grain, soybean meal and soybean oil.

Free on Board (FOB): shipment term used to indicate whether the seller or the buyer is liable for goods during shipping.

Gross Value of Agricultural Production (VBP): it represents the performance development of crops and livestock over the year and corresponds to the gross income inside the farms.

NOTES

- **1.** For methodological reasons and to preserve the anonymity of farmers, production data in cities with less than three farms of a given crop are omitted from the survey.
- **2.** The Ministry of Economy retroactively updates its database; therefore, the information listed may differ from the surveys made at later dates.
